DETAILS: AT WASHINGTON, D. C.

Reference report of the writer contained the results of the constant physical surveillance being conducted on the subject through the night of August 13, 1943, and subsequent constant physical surveillance is being reported as follows:

Through surveillance conducted by Special Agents A. J. DICKINSON and S. D. KARPEN on August 14, 1943, the subject was known to have remained in his room until 10 a.m., at which time he entered the hotel lobby. At 10:30 a.m., subject was met by Lieutenant Colonel RODRIGO and at 10:45 a.m., subject returned to his room. Subject remained in his hotel until 11:30 a.m., at which time he left going by taxi to the Spanish Embassy. He left the Spanish Embassy at 12:30 p.m., returning to his hotel. At 12:40 p.m., subject left the Statler by taxi going to the Mayflower Hotel where he was met by Lieutenant Colonel RODRIGO and an unidentified man for lunch. At 3 p.m., subject returned to his hotel.

At 5:30 p.m., the subject's party left the Statler Hotel going to the residence of FRAZER located at 27th Place and Military Road for cocktails, and the party was later known to have dined together. 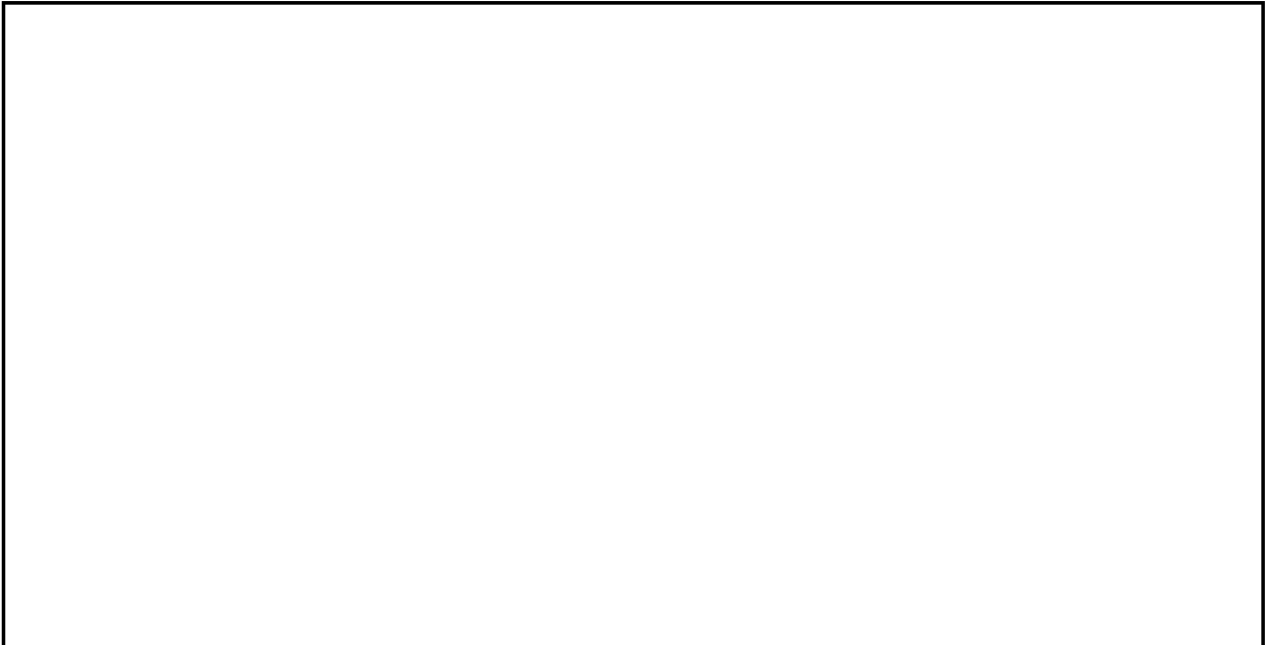
