Dear Requester:

This letter serves as a final response to your 26 December 2022 appeal to the CIA Agency Release Panel (ARP) of the initial release determination regarding your **Executive Order 13526** request referenced above for **CSHP 258: Covert Book Publishing.** 

The ARP carefully considered your petition and has reversed the Agency's initial determination as we relayed it to you in our 15 December 2022 response. The material previously denied in full may now be released in part. Still-redacted portions must continue to be withheld on the basis of Sections 3.3(h)(2) and 6.2(d) of Executive Order 13526. A copy of the redacted document accompanies this correspondence.

As the Executive Secretary of the ARP, I am the CIA official responsible for informing you that, as a result, your appeal has been *Granted in Part*.

You have the right to appeal this determination to the Interagency Security Classification Appeals Panel within 60 days of the date of this letter. 


