Your letter of 28 May 2009 requested an Executive Order 12958, as amended, mandatory declassification review of "A listing or printout of the monographs and histories produced at the CIA as part of the DDS&T Historical Papers collection."

We completed a thorough search of our records and located one document responsive to your request. We have determined that this document no longer meets the requirements for classification under Executive Order 12958, as amended (2003). We must withhold some material in the document on the basis of Section 3.5(c) of the Order. Enclosed is a copy of the document showing our deletions and citing our exemption.

You may appeal my decision to the Agency Release Panel, in my care, within 45 days from the date of this letter. Please include the basis of your appeal.
