This communication is the Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) final response to your request for agency records made under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (FOIA). Your request was received on December 6, 2024, and formally acknowledged on December 20, 2024.

Request

“A copy of the WAPA FOIA Case Log for each year between 2000 and present. If FOIA Case Logs are not available for all years during that entire span of time, then I instead request all the years for which the FOIA Case Logs are retrievable. In case you are not familiar with the term FOIA Case Log, it is a listing of the FOIA requests received by WAPA during that period of time, and likely includes the name and affiliation of the requester, the case number, the request date, the completion date, and of course the subject or topic of the request. If there are requests by people asking about themselves (first party requests or privacy act requests) you may omit their names.”

Response

WAPA searched for and gathered records responsive to your request. WAPA collected 30 pages of responsive records from knowledgeable agency personnel in the FOIA Office and the electronic information systems where searches were performed in the FOIAXPress system. Those 30 pages accompany this communication, with minor redactions applied under 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). A more detailed explanation of the applied exemptions follows.

Exemption 6 serves to protect Personally Identifiable Information (PII) contained in agency records when no overriding public interest in the information exists. WAPA does not find an overriding public interest in a release of the information redacted under Exemption 6—specifically, names and email addresses. This information sheds no light on the executive functions of the agency and WAPA finds no overriding public interest in its release. WAPA cannot waive these redactions, as the protections afforded by Exemption 6 belong to individuals and not to the agency.

Lastly, as required by 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(8)(A), information has been withheld only in instances where (1) disclosure is prohibited by statute, or (2) WAPA foresees that disclosure would harm an interest protected by the exemption cited for the record. When full disclosure of a record is not possible, the FOIA statute further requires that WAPA take reasonable steps to segregate and release nonexempt information. The agency has determined that in certain instances partial disclosure is possible and has accordingly segregated the records into exempt and non-exempt portions.

Certification

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 1004.7, I am the individual responsible for the records search and information release described above. FOIA request WAPA-2025-01455-F is now closed with the responsive agency information provided.

Appeal

Note that the records release certified above is final. Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8, you may appeal the adequacy of the records search, and the completeness of this final records release, within 90 calendar days from the date of this communication. Appeals should be addressed to:
